Dear Parents, Guardians, and Students,

We hope you are having a great summer! We are excited to welcome all students back to school this August. Attached is the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade supply list for the upcoming 2020-2021 school year. It is important for students to be at school every day, well prepared, with all of the necessary materials, in order to be successful. With the Covid-19 virus still prevalent, we will NOT be sharing supplies with each other. Sharing will be significantly LESS than normal to help in NOT spreading the virus. Students will NOT have a locker this year; therefore, it is very important to have a sturdy backpack that can be hung on a hook. Students should NOT be juggling a multitude of items between classes. Student items should be able to fit in a large backpack.

In addition to the supply list, the following items will be used for projects throughout the school year and should be kept at home until notified by the teacher. If purchased in advance (and on sale) this may eliminate the last-minute run to Walmart during the school year.

- Poster Board (for science and social studies projects)
- Extra pencils, “lead” mechanical pencils with “lead” refills, pens, markers, etc. to be kept at home for projects, homework, and to replenish personal supplies at school.

The Bennett Academy uniform is: (Expectations also will be posted in the school student handbook.)

- Beige khaki or black bottoms: skirts, shorts, and long pants are acceptable
  - Skirts and shorts must be NO SHORTER than 2 inches above the knee – please do not have anything shorter – if you do, you will be asked to change immediately.
  - Pants must be at least 1-inch from the floor.
  - Oversized pants and cargos are not allowed (students who have exposure of undergarments due to sagging pants or low-waisted pants will be asked to change their clothes to attire that fits appropriately). A belt may be asked to be worn; however, if undergarments are still visible with a belt, then the student must change his/her pants.
  - Tears in clothing, ragged edges in clothing, or any type of holes in clothing are not permitted.
- A Bennett Academy polo shirt with the embroidered logo (contact the office for purchase locations)
  - Polo shirts must be purple, white, gold, or black without any collar or cuff decoration.
- The uniform **must** fit properly, be clean, and (offensive) odor free. Sometimes students like to wear an undershirt. The uniform shirt must hang below and longer than any undershirt.
- Red Bennett Academy shirts may be awarded for outstanding achievement – these may be worn on Fridays.
- Closed-toed shoes are to be worn with MATCHING socks.
  - Athletic shoes work best for comfort and physical education.
  - Sandals, flip flops, or any other open toed shoes are NOT to be worn for your safety
- Solid black zip-up hoodies or solid black sweatshirts may be worn when the temperature is **below 80** degrees, these must fit properly – NO OTHER COLORS, NO DESIGNS, NO LOGOS – **JUST SOLID BLACK**. **This is always an issue; please know that your child will be asked to remove their outerwear should this policy be in violation.** The school does have some gently-used, clean black outerwear for sale.
